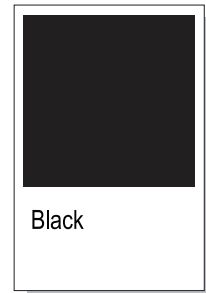





| 2 | Reset | Reset and Re-pair Remote: Follow the instructions on the remote label |
| 3 | HDMI | Connect an HDMI cable from the streaming device to your high-definition TV |
| 4 | USB(Type-C) | Connect the Power Adapter to power on the streaming device |


Turn on your TV before using the onn 4k Plus Streaming Device.

2. Set Input Source Of TV


After your TV is turned on, go to the Inputs page where you can switch the input source. Select HDMI Input, e.g. HDMI1.

Connect the streaming device to TV with an HDMI cable. Check what HDMI Input you are connecting to, e.g. HDMI1. After the device is powered on, the LED Indicator changes from red to white.





Insert the 2 AAA batteries into the remote. Hold both **BACK** and **HOME** button on the remote until pairing is successful.







